In 2001 we established the Long Island Community Chest to raise money to help individuals and families in need across Long Island. In 2003 we created the Long Island Fight for Charity, which quickly became one of Long Island's most exciting and most anticipated annual networking and fund-raising events. 
STEVE "SLOWHAND" BERNSTEIN






Michael believes Fight for Charity has offered him a unique and meaningful way to
